New Meeting Location

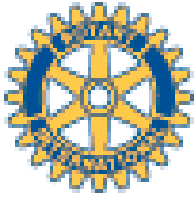

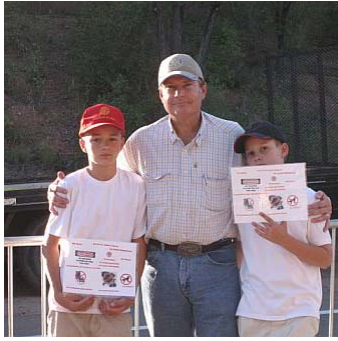
